

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE JAFFREY PUBLIC BEACHES

All persons using the Jaffrey Public Town Beaches are expected to comply with the following rules and regulations, and corresponding Town Ordinances and NH RSA.

1. All persons using the beach facilities are expected to comply with all requests made by the beach staff in matters of safety and behavior.
2. The hours of operation for beaches are posted. The facility is open from 8am – dusk daily. Lifeguard hours are posted.
3. Lifeguards will not assume responsibility for unattended or unsupervised children.
4. Swimming is only allowed in the areas designated by marking lines and buoys.
5. Acts endangering others, disorderly conduct, intoxication, and obscene or indecent acts are strictly prohibited and are grounds for immediate expulsion.
6. Alcohol or illegal substances are prohibited. (Town Ordinance)
7. Firearms, weapons, fireworks, or any explosive devices are prohibited.
8. Missing persons must be immediately reported to a Lifeguard.
9. Masks and goggles are permitted, not snorkels or fins. Scuba and underwater equipment are prohibited.
10. Fishing is not allowed in the designated swim area.
11. Flotation devices **are not allowed** except during supervised swim lessons. Physically or mentally challenged individuals may utilize an approved device with Lifeguard approval.
12. Motorized vehicles are not allowed on the beach.
13. Dogs, horses, or other animals are not permitted on the beach or in the water.
14. Fires and grills are not permitted on the beach area. Fires in other areas must be contained in a grill.
15. No glass containers allowed on the grounds.
16. Dispose of trash properly in waste containers provided or carry out. Please clean up your area when you are preparing to leave.
17. Children who are not strong swimmers must be accompanied by an adult.
18. Swimmers must wear appropriate attire.
19. Police will be notified of any vehicle left in the parking lot after operating hours.
20. The Town of Jaffrey is not responsible for lost or stolen personal belongings. The beach staff will maintain a lost and found throughout the summer.
21. Persons choosing not to comply with the above rules or repeated requests by the beach staff will be evicted from the area.
